WHAT IS RULE 20A?

- Rule 20 allows the conversion of existing overhead power lines and other equipment to underground facilities
- Rule 20A is a subprogram of Rule 20 that allocates ratepayer-funded work credits to Cities for projects that meet eligibility criteria of public interest
- Cities annually receive Rule 20A work credit allocations.
- Rule 20A funds must be committed to a utility underground district (UUD) established by resolution

CURRENT STATE OF TORRANCE RULE 20A FUNDS

- In 2021 CPUC discontinues the Rule 20A program
- City was notified by SCE in July 2024 that UUD No. 18A (Hawthorne Blvd) has been deemed inactive
- City's current Rule 20A balance of \$3,893,306 must be allocated to a new UUD prior to June 1, 2025 to avoid forfeiture of Rule 20A funds

UUD QUALIFYING CRITERIA

A UUD must meet one or more of the following public interest criteria:

1. Eliminate a heavy concentration of overhead power lines
2. Involve a street with a high volume of traffic
3. Benefit a civic or public recreation area of unusual scenic interest
4. Be classified as an arterial or major collector street

SUGGESTED UUDS FOR COUNCIL CONSIDERATION

1. Madrona Ave (Civic Center Dr to Torrance Blvd)
 - 1a. Madrona Ave (Civic Center Dr to Carson St)
2. Crenshaw Blvd (Del Amo Blvd to Dominguez St)
3. 190th St (Van Ness Ave to Western Ave)
4. Hawthorne Blvd (186th St to Del Amo Blvd)

1. Madrona Ave (Civic Center Dr to Torrance Blvd)



- ROM Cost: \$3,650,000
- Adjacent to Civic Center

1a. Madrona Ave (Civic Center Dr to Carson St)



- ROM Cost: \$16,000,000
- Extension of Option 1 corridor to Carson St

2. Crenshaw Blvd (Del Amo Blvd to Dominguez St)



- ROM Cost: \$4,350,000
- Adjacent to Mary K. Giordano RTC

3. 190th St (Van Ness Ave to Western Ave)



- ROM Cost: \$9,250,000
- Adjacent to several projects currently in development

4. Hawthorne Blvd (186th St to Del Amo Blvd)



- ROM Cost: \$15,550,000
- Heavily travelled commercial corridor
- Power lines exist on both sides of the street
